My university degree has consistently emphasised the importance of user research and understanding in design. Through coursework and projects, I have internalised the importance of comprehending user needs in order to craft successful designs. This insight informs my design approach, enabling me to create empathetic, intuitive experiences. I've predominantly refined these skills by conducting user interviews, surveys and A/B tests. I then analyse this data by creating affinity diagrams to identify any emerging trends or points of interest.

user experience design

Entering my final year of design studies, I've concentrated my efforts on user experience design. I hold a deep appreciation and understanding for the meticulous research and consideration integral to crafting user interfaces that achieve simplicity, intuitiveness, and visual appeal. The latest project I've been working on for my capstone course targets the mindfulness needs of stressed young adults targets who want to practice mindfulness but struggle to commit due to the busy nature of their every day lives. This need is met through a desktop plugin which gives users the chance to set a goal for how frequently they want to practice. Throughout the day, the plugin will gently remind users to pause, offering simple and short activities that promote mindful pause and reflection.
